Around 4 to 5 a.m., it symbolizes the coming of the end of treatment for the cancer patient. Once again they are tired, but they know they will make it.

The sun rising represents the end of treatment for the cancer patient. They see the light at the end of the tunnel and know that life will go on. The morning light brings on a new day, full of life, excitement, and new beginnings for the cancer patient. As a participant, you will feel the brightness of the morning and know that the end of the Relay is close at hand.

When you leave the Relay, think of the cancer patient leaving their last treatment. Just as you are exhausted and weak, so is that person after treatment.

But remember, never give up on the hope that one day, with everyone's help, there will be a cure!

This year's Relay For Life is set for Friday, June 1, 2007 and will take place at the Pendleton County Fairgrounds. Teams are still needed. The money raised by this event goes to The American Cancer Society to help find a cure.



**Gene Snyder Airport** The Falmouth/Gene Snyder Airport, named for the late Congressman M.G. "Gene" Snyder, who passed away in February of 2007, was built in 1984. It is located four miles north of Falmouth and handles over 2,500 takeoffs and landings every year. The facility has two airport and four private hangars for housing aircraft. Self-service fuel fill-up is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The runway length is 4000 x 75. Randy Wolfe serves as the Chairman of the Board for the airport.
