



The Licking River: The finest fresh water fishing in all of the Northern Kentucky/Cincinnati area is found on this river that runs throughout Pendleton County. Pendleton County borders the Ohio River which is great for striper or sauge. The South Licking River is great for small mouth fisheries.

Hunting Paradise: Hunters from far and wide annually traverse to Pendleton County, as we are known as one of the finest deer and wild turkey hunting areas in the state. Pendleton County ranks number 3 in the state for turkey harvest, ranks number 5 for the number of deer killed and Pendleton County has the record for the biggest deer killed in the state and that deer ranks number 5 in the world.

Joey Wells Memorial Licking River Boat Ramp: Located in the Shoemakertown Landing section of the City of Falmouth. Provided by the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife The ramp allows small fishing and recreational boat access to the Licking River.

Purchasing fishing/hunting license, hunting and fishing licenses are available locally at Wells Open Air Market and Sporting Goods, 109 Second Street, Falmouth, Ky. Phone (859) 654-3933. Auburn Handy Mart, and at Kincaid Lake State Park, You can also purchase license by phone, call toll free 1-877-KYTAG-01 (877-598-2401). To purchase a license through the internet visit fw.ky.gov. Hunting licenses allow the holder to take legal game species statewide by gun, bow, dog or falconry. Deer and turkey hunters must have deer or turkey permits in addition to the appropriate hunt-



ing license. Migratory bird hunters must have a migratory bird permit or a waterfowl permit in addition to the hunting license.

Fishing Licenses allow the holder to take sport and rough fish statewide by rod and reel, pole or line, or other specified legal methods. Trout fishermen must also have a trout permit.

Combination Licenses allow the holder to perform any act authorized by either a hunting or fishing license.
